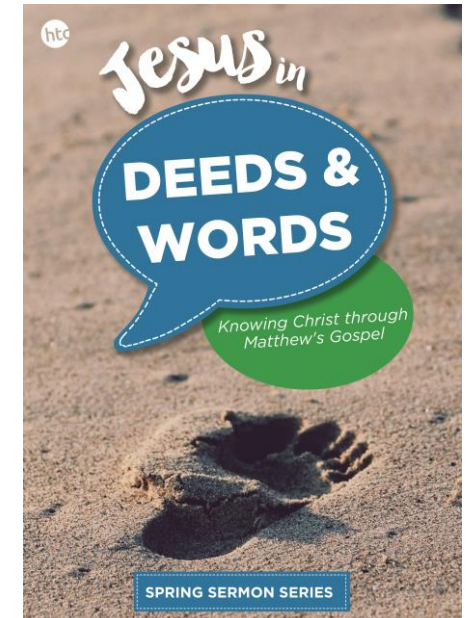

During the 9.30am service

A crèche is available in the **Ministry Centre** every Sunday during the 9.30am service and provides a safe and caring environment for babies and children from **0 - 2 years**.

All children **aged 3 - 14** start by coming into church for a time of worship then go to their groups except when there is an All Age Service. These services are short (45 min) and child friendly.

During the 6.30pm service

Pathfinders (years 7-9) come into church for the beginning of the 6.30pm service for worship and fellowship. They then go out to the Ministry Centre for age-specific teaching and games. It's a great time to hang out and learn more about God whilst having fun with friends.

Youth Fellowship (years 10-13) attends the 6.30pm service and then move to Emmanuel Hall at 8pm to learn more from the Bible together. A chance to connect with the wider church and one another while becoming deeper followers of Jesus.

Holy Week at HTC

Everyone is welcome to join us for our special services during Holy Week.

Compline: 8-8.30pm Monday 21 - Wednesday 23 March

Compline is a short service of Evening Prayer, which is held in the apse at the front of church. The service includes liturgy, readings and prayers. Everyone is welcome to join us.

Tenebrae Service: Jesus goes to Gethsemane

8-9pm Maundy Thursday 24 March

Everyone is welcome to join us for this special candlelit service. We mark the growing isolation of Jesus on Maundy Thursday by extinguishing candles as we hear about, reflect on and pray through Jesus' agonies in the garden of Gethsemane.

Walk of Witness: Good Friday 25 March

We meet in the station car park at 10am and walk behind the cross to Holy Trinity, as we remember Jesus' journey to the cross. Do also join us for our all age service at 10.30am (followed by hot cross buns) and our reflective service at 2pm.
