

Working Party to the Jonas Centre



Monday 29 May – Friday 2 June 2017

Why are we going?

The Jonas Centre in Wensleydale, run by former HTC member Simon Eastwood, is one of our mission partners. It is a Christian holiday and retreat centre that, alongside regular bookings from organisations and individuals, offers subsidised holidays to those in need.

We support them regularly through giving and prayer and also by sending an annual working party to the centre to help in a variety of ways.

During the week those who go will have the opportunity to help Simon and the staff at the centre in any way we are able, and to enjoy some of the peace and tranquillity of this very special place.

What will we do?

The trip is for 5 days during half term week, from Monday 29 May – Friday 2 June. The Monday and Friday will mainly be travel days, leaving us three full days at the centre. On Tuesday and Wednesday we will be helping Simon around the centre.

Tasks will typically include general ground maintenance and gardening, painting, simple building tasks, cleaning and sorting some of the communal areas. However, if people come with specific skills these will be well used, e.g. in the past we have made curtains.

That will leave a day at the end of the week to enjoy the beautiful countryside and attractions of Wensleydale.

Who is welcome?

Absolutely anyone is welcome. Children of all ages will be very well catered for as they can either help out as much as they are able or just enjoy playing in the wide open spaces at the centre. If appropriate we will organise shared childcare between ourselves so that as many people as possible can be available to work.

What is the accommodation?

We will be staying in the log cabins at the centre. These are two-bedroom self-catering cabins with a fully-equipped kitchen, heating, television and Wifi. We will need to bring our own towels and bed linen. Families will have their own cabin but it would be helpful if couples would be willing to share cabins and people coming on their own could either share rooms and/or cabins.

Catering arrangements will depend on how many people apply. We are likely to be responsible for making our own breakfast but then would probably share the rest of our meals together.

What is the cost?

The cost of the accommodation will be £280 per cabin for the 4 nights. This works out as £280 per family, £140 for a couple or single person sharing a cabin and £70 for a single person sharing a room.

On top of this there will also be the cost of travel to the centre and a contribution towards the cost of meals shared together.
