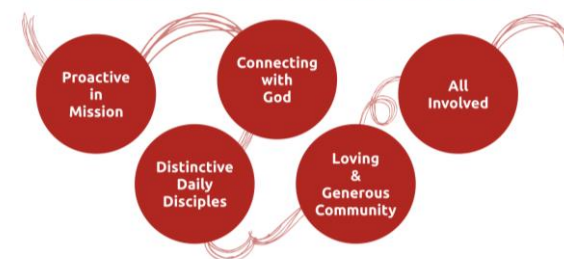

Sundays for ages 0 - 18

Ages 0-11: During the 9.30am service

A crèche is available in the **Ministry Centre** every Sunday during the 9.30am service and provides a safe and caring environment for babies and children from **0 - 2 years**.

All children **aged 3 - 11** come into church for a time of worship then go to groups except when there is an All Age Service, which is short (45 min) and child friendly.

Ages 11-18: During the 6.30pm service

At HTC we care about young people and there is a lot going on for anyone aged 11-18. Each term we have socials for different age groups, we go away annually for our Encounter Weekends and Summer Camps, and we meet on Sunday evenings to spend time hanging out, getting to know each other and God better, and having a place to ask the big – and most important – questions. All are welcome.



Pathfinders (years 7-9) are part of the 6.30pm congregation, they leave to 'catch the walking train' to Emmanuel Hall - our Youth Building - 4 minutes walk away. Pathfinders finishes at 8pm, direction cards for collection are on the welcome desk.

Youth Fellowship (years 10+) are also part of the 6.30pm service congregation; they then 'catch the walking train' to Emmanuel Hall for an 8pm start, finishing at 9.30pm.



Small Groups at HTC

Why? Small groups are a key part of our discipleship, helping us grow closer to God and one another as we follow Jesus. Bible studies follow our Sunday sermon series - and we also pray together, support one another and seek to reach out into the community.

Who? Small groups are for everyone! We have groups for all adults from 20s & 30s through to ages 80+!

When? Groups generally meet fortnightly at homes in Claygate and the surrounding area - some in the daytime and others in the evenings. There is a daytime group which meets in the Ministry Centre.
