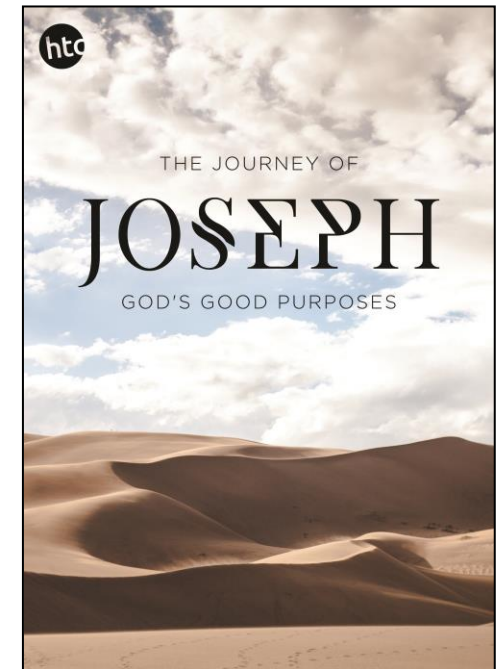

Sundays for ages 0 - 18

During the 9.30am service

A crèche is available in the **Ministry Centre** every Sunday during the 9.30am service and provides a safe and caring environment for babies and children from **0 - 2 years**.

All children **aged 3 - 14** start by coming into church for a time of worship then go to their groups except when there is an All Age Service. These services are short (45 min) and child friendly.

During the 6.30pm service

Pathfinders (years 7-9) come into church for the beginning of the 6.30pm service for worship and fellowship. They then go out to the Ministry Centre for age-specific teaching and games. It's a great time to hang out and learn more about God whilst having fun with friends.

Youth Fellowship (years 10-13) attends the 6.30pm service and then move to Emmanuel Hall at 8pm to learn more from the Bible together. A chance to connect with the wider church and one another while becoming deeper followers of Jesus.

Small Groups at HTC

Why? Small groups are a key part of our discipleship at HTC, and aim to help us grow deeper and closer as we follow Jesus. Small group Bible studies follow our Sunday sermon series - and we also pray together, support one another and seek to reach out into the community.

Who? Small groups are for everyone! We have groups for all adults ranging from our 20s & 30s group through to groups for ages 80+!

When? Groups generally meet fortnightly at homes in Claygate and the surrounding area - some meet in the daytime and others in the evenings. There is a daytime group which includes a crèche and meets in the Ministry Centre.
